Award Criteria

The Emerging Leader Award is an individual award that recognises a rising star, aged 35 or under, currently working in local government.

The Award recognises young professionals who have already made a notable contribution to the sector and have demonstrated the potential for leadership and continuing service.

Nominees for this award will demonstrate initiative in developing innovative work practices and programs or creative problem solving. They will actively contribute to a work environment that is respectful, collegiate and supportive, and be an excellent role model for other young professionals in local government.

Supporting material may be provided as a single PDF attachment, no more than 4 pages in total.

Assessment criteria

An independent judging panel will assess all submissions.
Each nomination will be considered in the local council and community context.
Larger funded projects will not necessarily be rated higher than smaller initiatives.
The judges’ decision is final, and no communication will be entered into concerning the final decision.
