Award Criteria

The Raymond West Lifetime Achievement Award celebrates and recognises those who have been in the local government for over 25 years.

The award is for an individual in recognition of significant and enduring contribution to the local government sector, and for valuable enrichment of the community.

This award recognises exceptional service, outstanding achievement and significant contribution to advancing the goals of the local government sector and personal contributions given in pursuit of benefits for the community.

The nomination will identify noteworthy and exemplary contributions to local government during a career spanning at least 25 years, commitment to professional growth as demonstrated by career path and professional achievements and service as a role model or mentor that shows dedication to the advancement of professionalism in local government.

About Raymond West

Raymond West was the Town Planner in Shepparton, in country Victoria, from 1927 to 1960.

West exemplified a life dedicated to public service. His legacy includes founding the organisation that grew into LG professionals. West believed the municipal workforce needed to be well qualified, learned, and professional.

West is remembered for an imaginative approach to civic improvement, advocating town planning, drawing up a scheme for financing the construction of new streets and urging council to proceed with a sewerage system.

When not occupied with his official duties, West endeavoured to improve the cultural life of Shepparton by encouraging public appreciation of history, art and music.
